

RESOLUTION SUPPORTING FEDERAL LEGISLATION
DEALING WITH EXTENDED MEDICAL INSURANCE COVERAGE

March 5, 1986

The AAML supports Federal legislation dealing with extended medical insurance coverage in the event of divorce or death for five years and that a conversion be offered thereafter:

Be it resolved that the Secretary of the Department of Health and Human Services rescind that portion of the regulations implementing expedited processes pursuant to Public Law 98-378 which precludes the states from using “a judge of the court” and thus denies the states their congressional mandated flexibility and guaranteed rights to use their judicial systems to meet expedited process requirements.
