was appointed as a Family Court Judge in June 2021 by New York City Mayor Bill DeBlasio.

She earned her B.A. from the University of North Carolina – Chapel Hill and her law degree from St. John’s University School of Law.

After graduating from law school, Judge Walker embarked on her legal career with the New York City Administration for Children’s Services, Family Court Legal Services Division. During this time, she worked in The Bronx, proudly serving the community where she grew up. Judge Walker dedicated 11 years at ACS, progressing from a legal intern to Assistant Borough Chief in Queens County. Her work involved litigating and supervising hundreds of cases related to child abuse and neglect.

Before her appointment to the bench, Judge Walker spent 5 years as a Court Attorney-Referee in Bronx and Queens Family Courts. In this role, she presided over matters concerning custody, visitation, and family offenses. Currently, Judge Walker continues to preside in Queens Family Court, primarily handling cases related to custody, visitation, and family offenses.
